

Purposes:

4. As God makes it possible, to serve older brethren, giving them an opportunity to live in a Sabbatarian environment and to use their wisdom and experience to teach the young (Ex 20:12; Lev 19:32; 1Tim 5:1).
5. As God makes it possible, to help and teach brethren to be fruitful individuals in spite of personal difficulties and limitations (Matt 15:30-32; Prov 31:9; Lev 19:14; 1John 3:17).
6. To be a repository of Bible study literature and to disseminate it as God makes it possible (Prov 23:23; John 8:32; Mark 16:15; 1Cor 9:18).
7. To chronicle the experiences of the community in word, song and other media, to be an inspiration and an encouragement to others for similar communities and local church congregations (Acts 4:20; Matt 28:20; 1Tim 4:12).
